However, the degree to which individuals may be affected ranges from mild spelling difficulties to severe organizational problems or complete illiteracy. Adult dyslexia is difficult to recognize and identify as it's a problem that many people either don't realize they have or they try to hide it. Simple tasks that a person

with dyslexia may try to perform may become increasingly more difficult, such as taking down a message, which can lead to frustration and anxiety.
