Wraak Wouter Laumans, Marijn Schrijver, 2019-06-07 Wraak is het langverwachte vervolg op de bestseller Mocro Maffia, waarvan inmiddels meer dan 100.000 exemplaren verkocht zijn. Het werd genomineerd voor de prestigieuze Bruseprijs 2015 voor het beste journalistieke boek en vormde de basis voor de veelgeprezen serie Mocro Maffia op Videoland. Na de dubbele liquidatie in de Amsterdamse Staatsliedenbuurt in 2012 veranderde het misdaadlandschap voorgoed. Gewelddadiger, roekelozer, complexer dan ooit. Het vormde het startschot van de nietsontziende oorlog tussen twee groepen in de onderwereld: enerzijds die rondom Benaouf A., het beoogde doelwit van die aanslag, anderzijds de groep rondom Gwenette Martha. Na diens dood in mei 2014 lijkt de vete aanvankelijk tot een einde te zijn gekomen, maar niets is minder waar. De strijd om kilo's coke gaat door, maar is niet langer de enige aanleiding voor de talloze aanslagen die volgen. Een ander motief blijkt ook een belangrijke rol te spelen. Wraak gaat verder waar Mocro Maffia ophield. Gebaseerd op uitgebreide research en talloze ontcijferde pgp-berichten vertelt het een verhaal over jonge jongens die snel op willen klimmen in het milieu en daar alles voor overhebben. Maar daarvoor betalen ze vaak een hoge prijs.

Cultural Contestation Jeroen Rodenberg, Pieter Wagenaar, 2018-07-04 Heritage practices often lead to social exclusion, as such practices can favor certain values over others. In some cases, exclusion from a society's symbolic landscape can spark controversy, or rouse emotion so much so that they result in cultural contestation. Examples of this abound, but few studies explicitly analyze the role of government in these instances. In this volume, scholars from a variety of academic backgrounds examine the various and often conflicting roles governments play in these processes—and governments do play a role. They act as authors and authorizers of the symbolic landscape, from which societal groups may feel excluded. Yet, they also often attempt to bring parties together and play a mitigating role.

Het was een moordzaak die indertijd maar weinig publiciteit kreeg. Toch was het de start van een onderzoek dat een team van rechercheurs acht jaar lang in de ban hield. Het werd een onderzoek dat zijn weerga niet kende en met de dag bizarder werd. Het werd ook een onderzoek dat zich uiteindelijk ontpopte tot een verbeterd jacht op de hoofddader, een gewetenloze killer, een gevaarlijke en buitengewoon manipulatieve sociopaat, een man die een spoor van geweld en doden achter zich liet. Dit boek laat zich lezen als een fictieve politiethriller, maar is een waargebeurd verhaal met vermelding van de echte feiten. De auteur laat de lezer van het begin tot het einde, over zijn schouder het politieonderzoek meebeleven. Een unieke inkijk in de belevingswereld en de werkwijze van de recherche. Voor de auteur omlijst dit boek zijn afscheid na 48 jaar politiedienst.

Totaal 3 Marcel van Roosmalen, 2024-05-07 Maak nu Marcel van Roosmalens Totaal-serie compleet met Totaal 3, bomvol verloren gewaande reportages die grotendeels nooit in boekvorm zijn verschenen Als iemand zich de afgelopen jaren hard heeft gemaakt voor het genre van de reportage is het Marcel van Roosmalen wel. Voor dit derde deel dook hij diep zijn archieven in, want veel stukken bleken niet meer digitaal te bestaan, maar nog wel op papier. Zoals zijn reportage over de comeback van NCRV-coryfee Frank Masmeijer als quizmaster bij de commerciële televisie, de reeks waarvoor hij als liftende reporter ‘op zoek naar de ziel van het nieuwe Europa’ gaat en onderweg wordt beroofd, een hilarische reportage over een goedkope cruise op de Middellandse Zee, of zijn bezoek aan een ‘bejaardenparadijs’, een luxe verzorgingsflat waar welgestelde ouderen voor veel geld in de watten worden gelegd. De beste verloren gewaande reportages sinds 1996 staan in dit deel, waarmee de Totaal-trilogie, gekenmerkt door Van Roosmalens eigenzinnige gevoel voor understatement en zijn scherpe oog voor het menselijk tekort, is afgerond. Ze voelden zich er niet op hun gemak en konden met hun kind terecht bij de crèche die altijd al hun voorkeur had en die ooit als beste te boek stond. Maar bij nader inzien blijkt ook daar van alles mis te zijn. Poerink besluit de wereld van de kinderopvang verder te onderzoeken. Hij spreekt met directeuren en managers, drinkt koffie met politici en geeft raad aan een Kamercommissie. Hij maakt kennis met de wereld van private equityfondsen waar alles om geld draait. Vóór alles wil Poerink de positie van de ouder versterken. Het enige houvast is de Wet Kinderopvang, en dat wordt dan ook zijn doel. Maar hoe verander je een wet? In *De peuterindustrie* beschrijft Poerink de weg die hij als jonge vader aflegt in zijn strijd tegen een - in zijn ogen - falend kinderopvangsysteem.

Changing News Use Irene Costera Meijer,Tim Groot Kormelink,2020-11-09 Changing News Use pulls from empirical research to introduce and describe how changing news user patterns and journalism practices have been mutually disruptive, exploring what journalists and the news media can learn from these changes. Based on 15 years of audience research, the authors provide an in-depth description of what people do with news and how this has diversified over time, from reading, watching, and listening to a broader spectrum of user practices including checking, scrolling, tagging, and avoiding. By emphasizing people’s own experience of journalism, this book also investigates what two prominent audience measurements – clicking and spending time – mean from a user perspective. The book outlines ways to overcome the dilemma of providing what people apparently want (attentiongrabbing news features) and delivering what people apparently need (what journalists see as important information), suggesting alternative ways to investigate and become sensitive to the practices, preferences, and pleasures of audiences and discussing what these research findings might mean for everyday journalism practice. The book is a valuable and timely resource for academics and researchers interested in the fields of journalism studies, sociology, digital media, and communication.

Combating Illicit Trade in Tobacco Products Stanisław Tosza,John A. E. Vervaele,2022-02-17 This book focuses on the enforcement aspect of tobacco control policy, and argues that the intense regulation of the tobacco market will never be successful as long as it can be circumvented by the availability of illicit tobacco products. Yet, current efforts to combat illicit tobacco trade are insufficient, suffering from several flaws and gaps at the regulatory and operational levels. The aim of this book is to provide an analysis of the legal framework and practice of enforcement with regard to illicit tobacco products. Combining criminological and legal perspectives, it presents and critically analyses the phenomenon of illicit tobacco trade, as well as the policies, legal frameworks and practices in six EU countries with regard to combatting this phenomenon, assessing the strengths and weaknesses of their approaches. Furthermore, it studies the relationship between the EU and third countries (e.g. Ukraine) in terms of how the EU can influence policy and enforcement in these countries in order to counter illicit tobacco trafficking. Not exclusively focusing on the EU, the book also includes an analysis of enforcement against illicit tobacco products in the US. The EU Member States analysed in the book (Belgium, Germany, Italy, Latvia, the Netherlands and Poland) reflect the range of currently available approaches. Some of them have ratified the WHO Protocol against tobacco smuggling; others have not. They belong to different legal traditions and face different challenges due to their respective border situations. While Belgium and the Netherlands are key entry ports to the EU, Poland and Latvia represent the Eastern land border of the EU, with various regional challenges. Italy has a long maritime border, where trafficking is possible from Northern Africa and from the Middle East. It also has significant experience in fighting organised crime. Lastly, Germany is the largest market in Europe and situated in the middle of these trafficking routes.

Narrating Migrations from Africa and the Middle East Ruth Breeze,Sarali Gintsburg,Mike Baynham,2022-09-08 Exploring narratives produced by different groups of MENA and SSA migrants or refugees, this book focuses on the spatial and temporal aspects of their experiences. In doing so, the authors examine a wide range of accounts of journeys to host countries and memories (or recreations) of “home”. The spaces that migrants occupy (or not) in their new country; the spaces and times they share with local populations; and different conceptions of space and time across generations are also investigated, as are how feelings surrounding space and time are manifested within these different narratives and their affective-discursive practices. Taking both a traditional, linear view of migration as well as a multilinear, multimodal approach, the book presents an in-depth investigation into the ways in which people inhabit multiple real and digital spaces.

Vijftien lessen die kleurrijke basisscholen ons leren Cordula Rooijendijk,2023-08-25 Wat kunnen we leren van de kleurrijke ‘zwarte school’? Dit boek spreekt niet alleen over het basisonderwijs, maar over de samenleving als geheel. Slecht onderwijs. Lerarentekorten. Ingewikkelde kinderen. Op kleurrijke ‘zwarte’ basisscholen lijkt van alles mis. Maar wie er gaat kijken, ziet dat het beeld dat er in onze samenleving van deze scholen bestaat aanpassing behoeft. Want welk type school levert bijvoorbeeld het hoogst mogelijke advies af voor de middelbare school? Dat is de islamitische basisschool. Cordula Rooijendijk, directeur van een basisschool in Amsterdam, bezocht tientallen kleurrijke scholen en vond er antwoorden op vragen, ook op die waarop ze geen antwoord zocht. Over hoe je echt goed onderwijs inricht, bijvoorbeeld. Want natuurlijk kampen kleurrijke scholen met grote uitdagingen. Maar desondanks, of misschien wel juist daardoor, gebeuren er ook heel bijzondere dingen, waarover je vrijwel nooit iets hoort in de media.
