The persons, places, and events are recorded chronologically in my story as they actually occurred in my life. Accept them as they are recorded, and don't attempt to group different parts of my story together in any unique way.

The Greek Junta and the International System Antonis Klapsis, Constantine Arvanitopoulos, Evanthis Hatzivassiliou, Effie G. H.
