Jedoch hat diese Umstellung mehrere Unklarheiten und Probleme, welche sich auf soziale, organisatorische sowie marktzusammenhängende Aspekte sowohl auf der Provider- (Versorger) als auch auf der Benutzerseite beziehen. Zuerst wird eine gründliche Literaturrecherche zu aktuellen mobilen Zahlungsmöglichkeiten in Deutschland durchgeführt, um herauszufinden, welche Schlüsselprobleme auf dem deutschen Markt existieren.
