Three years after the first revelation, Muhammad began preaching total surrender to God as the only acceptable path. typically complete the recitation of the whole Quran during tarawih prayers. In order to extrapolate the meaning of a particular Quranic verse, most Muslims rely on exegesis, or tafsir.
