News Media in the Arab World Barrie Gunter, Roger Dickinson, 2013-06-06 News Media in the Arab World: A Study of 10 Arab and Muslim Countries is based on ongoing research at the Department of Media and Communication, University of Leicester, and has investigated the rapidly changing nature of the news media in Arab countries. They have investigated the role of newspapers and television in news provision and the impact of new media developments, most especially the emergence of the internet as a platform for news distribution and of international satellite television channels such as Al Jazeera. Examining the constantly developing nature of news, the collection contains separately authored chapters produced by the researchers responsible for each original analysis, covering Bahrain, Egypt, Iraq, Kuwait, Libya, Oman, Qatar, Palestine, Saudi Arabia and the United Arab Emirates. Based on original primary and secondary research, this will be the first empirical-based collection to blend perspectives from both the Western and Arab

nations.

Television News in Saudi Arabia Mohammed Ravan Barayan, 2002 During the 1970s and 1980s, many viewers in both developed and developing countries found themselves able to receive new television channels, whether from near neighbours or via satellite from further a field. The public service broadcasters have inevitably been affected by the arrival and the activities of the new privatesector media. The arrival of the private channels played a role in many things in our life as people, and brought many problems to the governments especially in Asia and the Arab World. This study illuminates the various issues involved in this problem, focusing especially on the U.K. [BBC], Asia [China & India], and the Arab world [Saudi Arabia]. The quality of the news service on Saudi Television has been characterised by poor quality and has failed to satisfy Saudi viewers as indicated by some of the previous studies carried out during the years 1982, 1983, and 1987. At that time satellite broadcasting was still at its embryonic stage and Saudi viewers had no alternative available to them but since 1991 they started to receive broadcasts from a number of Arab and non-Arab satellite channels and this has increased the choices available to them. With the appearance of specialised satellite news channels the demand for stronger television news service became even more important, both at the official and national levels, in order to follow up what goes on in the world. The researcher conducted fieldwork study in Saudi Arabia, Qatar and London during the period from 15/01/2000 to 15/3/2000.

This study of seven chapters is divided into four parts. The first part explores the views and impression of Saudi viewers about the quality of the news service of channel one of Saudi television and the three satellite channels under the study [Al-Jazeera, MBC, ANN], For this reason, the researcher interviewed eight groups of 48 persons [male & female] from the Saudi audience [(1) academics (2) officials) males (3) academics (4) doctors) females (5) King Saud University students (6) Imam Bin Saud University students (7) farmers and sales merchants (8) unemployed and uneducated) males]. The second part ascertains the news agenda and type of production in each of the four stations. A content analysis of a total of 497 news stories or the total production of the four stations in the week 12/2/2000 and ending 18/2/2000 was undertaken. The third part deals with the news department itself on the four stations, and how they work from the organisation, management, strategy and the employees. For this reason, the researcher interviewed the news makers [twenty persons]. The final part in this study was how can Saudi Television compete with satellite channels, for this reason, the researcher put forward some suggestions in the hope that may contribute to the development of the Saudi media work in general and television news service in particular [chapter 7]. What was found about the Saudi viewers is that they are dissatisfied with the Saudi Television news and they prefer the news service of the other channels under study. And we found the causes of the prevailing shortages and weaknesses in Saudi Television news service

[Channel One] into factors related to: 1. - Elements and stages of news service production in Saudi television. 2. -News service management. 3. - Employees of news service sector.

Us Media Coverage of Saudi Arabia and Us Officials' News Framing Abdulrahman Al-Zuhayyan, 2012-07 This book presents an analytical and predictive news-framing model that could be used to examine a foreign policy of a national state toward another foreign state. By examining how US mainstream television outlets portrayed Saudi Arabia as a case, the author was able to explore how US foreign policy is made, and how US media outlets work to achieve this policy and the mechanism used to cover a particular foreign country. Moreover, this model can explain the type of the current political relation between two national states whether it is normal, in dispute, conflictive, or at war. Also, the model can predict whether a political relationship can change from one state to another at a given time. The coined name by the author for this newsframing is Media Congruency Construction Frame. This book could be used by student of political science, international political communication, international relation, as well as journalism and media, in addition to politicians, media professionals, academicians, and the public to identify the ideological agenda that activates a particular foreign policy.

The Making of Arab News Noha Mellor, 2005 Since September 11, Arab and American journalists have been trading barbs, accusing each other of bias and a lack of objectivity. But is news coverage in Arab countries all that different from American coverage? The Making of Arab News draws comparisons, including examples of Arabic news language and their English translations, to show how Arab news values have been Americanized and how these values are reflected in the language used in the Arab news. Arab Women in Arab News Amal Al-Malki, David Kaufer, Suguru Ishizaki, Kira Dreher, 2012-03-15 This book addresses east-west understandings of Arab women as portrayed through translated media. The vast majority of media studies on Arab women are western-based. They study the effect of western stereotypes in western media depictions of Arab women. There is a vast scholarly literature tracing western stereotypes of Arab women from medieval times to the present. From 1800, the dominant western stereotype of Arab women depicts them as passive and oppressed. Thirty years of social science media research in the west has shown that media images of Arab women reinforce this two hundred year old stereotype. Much of this research has studied silent image bites of Arab women, where women are pictured in veils and their own voices are replaced by western captions or voice-overs. This book sets out to answer this question. To answer it, we contracted with a global news translation service from the Middle East to collect and translate a sample of 22

months of new summaries from 103 Arab media sources belonging to 22 Arab countries. Filtering the summaries that contained one or more female keywords (e.g., woman, mother, aunt, sister, she) yielded 2, 061 summaries between September 2005 and June of 2007. Using the 2,061 summaries as input data, a coding scheme was developed for active and passive female behaviors based on verbphrase analysis and conventions of Englishlanguage news-reporting.

Be that as it may, he become undesirable and went into deliberate outcast in the US in 2017. From that point, he composed a month to month section in the Washington Post in which he scrutinized the strategies of Crown prince Mohammed canister Salman, the child of Lord Salman and Saudi Arabia's true ruler. In his first segment for the Post in September 2017, Khashoggi said he had dreaded being captured in a clear crackdown on dispute managed by the sovereign. Jamal Ahmad Khashoggi (born 1958) is a Saudi journalist, columnist, author and the general manager and editor-in-chief of Al Arab News Channel. He was globally respected for his influences to Al Watan for its becoming a stage for Saudi reformists. Khashoggi was born in Madinah in 1958. He received fundamental and secondary education in Saudi Arabia. He acquired a bachelor's degree in business administration from Indiana State University in 1982. Jamal Khashoggi began his career as a regional manager for Tihama Bookstores from 1983 to 1984. Later, Khashoggi worked as a correspondent for the Saudi Gazette and an assistant manager for Okaz from 1985 to 1987. He continued his career as a reporter for numerous daily and weekly Arab newspapers from 1987 to 1990, including Al Sharq Al Awsat, Al Majalla and Al Muslimoon. He became managing editor and acting editor-in-chief of Al Madina in 1991 and his term continued until 1999. From 1991 to 1999, he was a foreign correspondent countries as Afghanistan, Algeria, Kuwait, Sudan and the Middle East. It is also alleged that he served with both Saudi Intelligence Agency and the United States in Afghanistan during this period. He then was appointed a deputy editor-in-chief of Arab News, the leading English newspaper of Saudi Arabia and aided in the post from 1999 to 2003. Khashoggi became the editor-in-chief of Al Watan for a short period, less than two months, in 2003.

Precisely, his term as editor-in-chief lasted for 52 days only. He was fired in May 2003 by the Saudi ministry of information after several commentaries published in the paper about the authoritative power of the religious establishment in Saudi Arabia. After this incident, he went to London in voluntary exile. There he merged with the Al Faisal's team as an adviser. Then, he assisted as a media aide to Prince Turki Al Faisal, while the latter was Saudi Arabia's ambassador to the United States. In April 2007, Khashoggi began to work as editor-in-chief in Al Watan for a second time. A column by poet Ibrahim al-Almaee stimulating the elementary Salafi premises was published in Al Watan in May 2010. Then, Khashoggi had to resign again on 17 May 2010. Al Watan broadcast that Khashoggi resigned as editor-in-chief to focus on his personal projects. However, it is thought that he was forced to resign due to official discontentment with articles published in the paper that were precarious of the Kingdom's harsh Islamic rules. After his second resignation from Al Watan in 2010, Khashoggi appointed by Al-Waleed bin Talal as director of the Al Arab News Channel in Bahrain. He was also political commentator for Saudi and international channels, including MBC, BBC, Al Jazeera and Dubai TV. Interviews with Osama bin
