However, Dr Kemp soon finds out about Griffin's acts of violence from the various newspaper reports. Realizing that the Invisible Man was a homicidal maniac, Kemp decides to hand him over to the authorities. He writes a letter to a colonel, and with his efforts, the long run of rampage of the Invisible Man is brought to an end. The Invisible Man was initially published in a serialized format in the Pearson's Weekly in 1897. The same year, all the pieces were compiled and published as a novel. Since its first publication, the novel has captured the imagination of readers and audiences around the world.
