The eastern section of the Oregon Trail, which followed the Missouri River through Kansas, Nebraska, and Wyoming, was shared by people traveling along the California, Bozeman, and Mormon Trails. These trails branched off at various points, and the California Trail diverged from the Oregon Trail at Fort Hall in southern Idaho. From there, the Oregon Trail moved northward, along the Snake River, then through the Blue Mountains to Fort Walla Walla. From there, travelers would cross the prairie before reaching the Methodist mission at The Dalles, which roughly marked the end of the Trail. The Trail stretched roughly half the country, and hundreds of thousands of settlers would use it, yet the Oregon Trail is famous not so much for its physical dimensions but for what it represented. As many who used the Oregon Trail described in memoirs, the West represented opportunities for adventure, independence, and fortune, and fittingly, the ever popular game named after the Oregon Trail captures that mentality and spirit by requiring players to safely move a party west to the end of the trail. Perhaps most famously, the game that helped popularize current generations' interest in the Oregon Trail highlighted the obstacles the pioneers faced in moving West. Indeed, as all too many settlers discovered, traveling along the Trail was fraught with various kinds of obstacles and danger, including bitter weather, potentially deadly illnesses, and hostile Native Americans, not to mention an unforgiving landscape that famous American explorer Stephen Long deemed unfit for human habitation. The big move west from the east and places in between resulted as nation acquired more and more and finally reached the Pacific Ocean. The major move west started just prior to the mid nineteenth century and was over before the end of that century. There will never be anything like that western expansion ever again. The era was the greatest movement of humanity that our nation ever saw and much of it took place on three major trails that were quite rough. The Santa Fe Trail provided a military supply route during the war with Mexico. Also many of the settler's journeys were on the trail. Dodge City, the wild west town and cattle rail-head, was to the east of the middle of the trail in later years. This trail fed into other ones, such as the Old Spanish Trail, once the wagon trains passed Santa Fe. The Oregon Trail connecting with the California Trail became a heavily travel route to the gold field area by less than civilized unruly gold seeking prospectors for about a five year period that partly after the middle of the nineteenth century. They were deadly serious people that killed many Native Americans to move them out of their way. Still some failed prospectors did quit mining there until they were penniless beggars. The Oregon Trail also brought farmers, cattlemen, cowboys, business people and educators west over the most of the second half of the century. Many immigrants came from the world by steamship to San Francisco. The settlers from the east were part of wagon trains. They took the main trail from Independence west they often off on anyone of a many routes that were kind the network of trails of the Oregon Trail. Then the expansion west ended prior to the twentieth century. All of these trails to the west provided great difficulties that the settlers needed to survive illness, attacks from outlaws and angry Native Americans before they could pursue their dreams of a better life in the west.
