Fixing the Facts Joshua Rovner,2011-07-26 What is the role of intelligence agencies in strategy and policy? How do policymakers use (or misuse) intelligence estimates? When do intelligence-policy relations work best? How do intelligence-policy failures influence threat assessment, military strategy, and foreign policy? The Limits of U.S. Military Capability James H. Lebovic, 2010-06-30 Political scientist James H. Lebovic cautions against involving the U.S. military in operations without first considering U.S. stakes and suggests that the military take a less-ismore approach when choosing to employ force. Ambitious goals bring higher costs, unexpected results, diminished options, and a greater risk of failure. Rejecting the heavy-handed approach that is typical of most comparisons between the Vietnam and Iraq wars, The Limits of U.S. Military Capability carefully assesses evidence to develop lessons applicable to other conflicts-especially the ongoing war in Afghanistan.

Caudillos in Spanish America, 1800-1850 John Lynch,1992 The caudlillo of Spanish America was both regional chieftain and, in the turbulent years of the early nineteenth century, national leader. His power base rested on ownership of land and control of armed bands. He was the rival of constitutional rulers and the precursor of modern dictators.
