Many of these young men too-became millionaires under his leadership, and some of them remain today at the top of the ladder of American industry But Mr. Carnegie worked and worked hard. His life has long been an open book to the American public, and few there are who do not wish the "Laird of Skibo" well in the happy enjoyment of his remaining years on the Scottish estate near the humble home of his youth, where his success is an inspiration to every young man and the most notable example of the opportunities afforded by business life in America. Every word of Mr. Carnegie's lecture is worth study. He speaks out of a ripe experience to young men, with a heart brim-full of kindness and human sympathy.
