It constitutes London's warning to his fellow socialists that mere persuasion is insufficient to combat a system that ultimately relies on force. Though London was a reader of Marx and Nietzsche and an avowed socialist, he doubted

that socialism could ever be put into practice and was convinced of the necessity for a brutal individualism. He thought of The Sea-Wolf (1904), the story of Wolf Larsen and his crew of outcasts on the lawless Alaskan seas, as "an attack upon the superman philosophy," but the Captain is far more memorable than any of the book's civilized characters.
