Lurking in the background is Andy Murray, a survivor of the Dunblane Massacre, now galvanised by his new tennis coach, legendary ex-player Ivan Lendl, and desperate for a slam triumph to exorcise the demons of past failures. Great expectations accompany these men into every major championship. And the expectations are exceeded.
