Dabei verknüpft sie nicht nur rassismuskritische, postkoloniale und sozioökonomische Dimensionen des Unbehagens, sondern nimmt auch Bezug auf die spezifisch-historischen Lebenserfahrungen in der DDR und der (Nach-)Wendezeit.

in 2013, Leistungssteigerungen in den Pflegestufen, eine staatliche
Förderung zur privaten Pflegevorsorge, dem sogenannten Pflege-
Bahr? und die Überlegung die Pflegeausbildung zu reformieren. Die
seit langem vorbereitete und geforderte Neudefinition des
Pflegeberufsbegriffes, bleibt die Pflegereform jedoch

weiterhin schuldig. In den Einrichtungen der stationären Altenpflege zeichnet sich abseits der politischen Sichtweise der Dinge ein einheitliches Stimmungsbild: Es ist bereits 75 nach 12?. Der Fachkräftemangel ist längst zur Realität geworden. Angesichts des steigenden Pflegebedarfs nehmen zunehmend mehr Einrichtungen ihr Glück selbst in die Hand und begeben sich auf der Suche nach qualifizierten Fachkräften auf die ausländischen Arbeitsmärkte. Gewaltprävention in der Altenpflege Silke

Wedemeyer, 2014-04-28 Masterarbeit aus dem Jahr 2013 im Fachbereich Pflegewissenschaften, Note: sehr gut, Donau-Universität Krems - Universität für Weiterbildung (Pflegewissenschaften), Veranstaltung: Pflegepädagogik, Sprache: Deutsch, Abstract: Gewalt in der Pflege alter Menschen ist systemimmanent, da nicht nur personelle, sondern auch strukturelle und kulturelle Gewalt wirksam werden. Unter pflegepädagogischem Aspekt stellt sich die Frage, welche Kompetenzen innerhalb der fachtheoretischen Ausbildung gefördert werden können und müssen, um gewaltpräventiv zu wirken. Innerhalb der als Ausbildungsziel formulierten Handlungskompetenz werden Fach- und Methodenkompetenz, Sozialkompetenz und Personalkompetenz unterschieden. Fehlende Fähigkeiten im Bereich der Personalkompetenz können an der Entstehung von personeller Gewalt beteiligt sein, als relevante Fähigkeiten wurden Reflexions- und Empathiefähigkeit sowie Kreativität identifiziert. Auf der Grundlage konstruktivistischer Überlegungen wurde ein Unterrichtsprojekt mit Altenpflegeschüler/innen im dritten Ausbildungsjahr durchgeführt,

welches diese Fähigkeiten steigern sollte. Die Auszubildenden schätzten die eigenen Fähigkeiten vor und nach dem Unterrichtsprojekt anhand eines Fragebogens ein, der mit SPSS 20 ausgewertet wurde. Die Frage nach dem Einfluss des Unterrichtsprojekts auf die Personalkompetenz in der Selbsteinschätzung der Auszubildenden wurde mit dem Ziel formuliert, eine Aussage über den möglichen Erfolg von Maßnahmen zur Gewaltprävention in der theoretischen Ausbildung treffen zu können. Reflexions- und Empathiefähigkeit wurden durch das Unterrichtsprojekt gesteigert, nicht jedoch die Kreativität. Die hohen Werte in allen Subskalen lassen einen Overconfidence Effect in der Selbsteinschätzung der Auszubildenden vermuten. Die Ergebnisse werden hinsichtlich ihrer Bedeutung für die Gewaltprävention und ethische Entscheidungsfindung in der Altenpflege, sowie für die theoretische und praktische Altenpflegeausbildung interpretiert.
