Semantic Technologies in Idea Management Systems: A Model for Interoperability, Linking and Filtering, Idea Management Systems are web applications that implement the notion of open innovation though crowdsourcing. Typically, organizations use those kind of systems to connect to large communities in order to gather ideas for improvement of products or services.
