Fostering the Culture of Convergence in Research

National Academies of Sciences, Engineering, and Medicine, Division on Earth and Life Studies, 2019-06-07 Convergence-based research approaches are critical in solving many scientific challenges, which frequently draw on large teams of collaborators from multiple disciplines.
