The enhanced role of the exchange rate reflects these economies' greater vulnerability to exchange rate shocks and their less developed financial markets. However, their sharper focus on the exchange rate may cause some confusion about the commitment of their central banks to achieve the inflation target and may also complicate policy implementation. Global inflation pressures, greater exchange rate volatility, and the financial stresses from the global financial turmoil that began in mid-2007 are heightening these tensions.

Monetary Policy and Exchange Rate Dynamics in a Behavioral Open Economy Model Marcin Kolasa, Sahil Ravgotra, Pawel Zabczyk, 2022-06-03 We develop an extension of the open economy New Keynesian model in which agents are boundedly rational à la Gabaix (2020). Our setup nests rational expectations (RE) as a special case and it can successfully mitigate many "puzzling"

aspects of the relationship between exchange rates and interest rates. Finally, we show that accounting for myopia exacerbates the small open economy unit-root problem, makes positive monetary spillovers more likely, and increases the persistence of net foreign assets and the real exchange rate.

The paper also shows that the four major EMU currencies locked their parities with the euro at a rate close to equilibrium.
