**The Price of Independence** Sheldon Danziger, Cecilia Elena Rouse, 2008-01-07 More and more young men and women today are taking longer and having more difficulty making a successful transition to adulthood. They are staying in school longer, having a harder time finding steady employment at jobs that provide health insurance, and are not marrying and having children until much later in life than their parents did.
