Controle De Natalidade Pode Evitar Que O Aquecimento Global Destrua O Mundo Felipe Braz Gonçalez Sanches, 2016-03-12 Tem gente demais Escrevi este livro para provar que a implementação do controle global de natalidade obrigatório, com apenas um filho por mulher, seria a solução para ajudar a conter o avanço de todos os males provocados pela humanidade na natureza. Trata-se de um trabalho de pesquisa com reportagens de jornais e revistas, entre novembro de 2007 e fevereiro de 2019, comprovando que o planeta Terra não terá condições de ser habitável com o contínuo aumento da população e do aquecimento global. Apesar dos alertas dos cientistas, a maior parte da população está ignorando o problema do agravamento da mudança climática em curso. E a conclusão deste trabalho de pesquisa com este livro aponta que a solução para combater o aumento do aquecimento global, apesar de ser técnica, social e política, passa pelo controle global de natalidade, pois não existe solução para um problema que não para de crescer, a não ser que seja atacada a sua raiz. Então temos de agir agora, pois a poluição e a devastação ambiental causada pela superpopulação humana, que atingiu a marca de 7 bilhões em outubro de 2011, ameaça a existência de vida na Terra. Atualmente mais de um bilhão de pessoas passam fome no mundo e é óbvio que o controle de natalidade evitaria também o aumento da miséria. A pesquisa prova que além de evitar a emissão de gases de efeito estufa que provoca o aumento do aquecimento do planeta Terra, o controle global de natalidade também seria a solução para ajudar a combater outros problemas relacionados ao meio ambiente, como o desmatamento, a perda da biodiversidade, a desertificação e a atual e futura ameaçadora escassez de água potável. Mas apesar da solução pelo controle demográfico ser de conhecimento dos políticos, eles não têm coragem de defender isso em público, por medo de perder votos. E para quem imagina que este livro seria um instrumento de discriminação contra os mais pobres, está enganado. O aquecimento global é provocado mais pelo sistema de vida, o alto consumo dos mais ricos (classe média incluída), que também são os maiores responsáveis pelo processo de destruição da natureza. Temos de agir agora, pois o mundo encontra-se sob risco de colapso ambiental. Já para quem acha que a minha "receita" do controle global de natalidade obrigatório, com apenas um filho por mulher, para evitar o colapso ambiental é exagerada, tem mais uma equação a ser considerada: o consumo global está crescendo mais do que a população. De acordo com o relatório O Estado do Mundo, publicado em 2010 pelo The Worldwatch Institute, nos últimos 50 anos o consumo cresceu seis vezes, ao mesmo tempo em que a população cresceu 2,2 vezes. Preocupados com essa situação, cientistas e ambientalistas estão se mobilizando no mundo todo. Segundo pesquisa da ONG (organização não governamental) americana Global Footprint Network, se nenhuma mudança for feita na velocidade do consumo e na taxa de crescimento da população, a escassez de recursos naturais pode se tornar realidade antes de 2050. A disponibilidade de água potável é a maior preocupação. Campanhas para

economizar água estão sendo realizadas no mundo todo. Isso ajuda, mas não resolve. E os alertas sobre o aumento da população e suas conseguências, no Brasil e no resto do mundo, são encontrados no noticiário dos jornais. Por exemplo, no jornal O Estado de São Paulo do dia 21 de marco de 2014 foi publicando o relatório da Oxford Martin Commission for Future Generations, que depois de confirmar que seremos 10 bilhões de pessoas no mundo em 2050, calcula que 60% do aumento da população em 2050 ocorrerão na Ásia e na África. E no jornal Folha de São Paulo do dia 6 de maio de 2012 foi publicado o relatório da Royal Society, que ao mesmo tempo em que adverte para a necessidade de reduzir o consumo e a produção de lixo, alerta que a população mundial poderá chegar a 20 bilhões em 2100. Então caro leitor, se nada for feito para impedir o aumento da população, o mundo passará a contar com 10 bilhões de habitantes em 2050 e com 20 bilhões em 2100. Diante desse quadro de desastre anunciado, a Organização das Nações Unidas (ONU), que já defende o planejamento familiar, deveria sugerir aos governantes de todos os países que decretassem o controle de natalidade obrigatório, com apenas um filho por mulher, para o tamanho da população ir diminuindo com o passar dos anos. Mas o problema é que já tem gente demais Segundo especialistas no assunto, o ideal seria se o planeta Terra não tivesse mais do que 3,5 bilhões de pessoas (a população do mundo em 1968). Então é preciso diminuir o tamanho da população mundial para no máximo 3,5 bilhões. E como isso deveria ser feito o mais rápido possível, um filho por mulher ainda é muito. Por isso é preciso fazer campanha na internet com objetivo de esclarecer que a maioria das mulheres do mundo não deve ter nenhum filho até que o aumento do aquecimento global seja contido. Este livro é recomendado principalmente para os políticos, pois eles precisam entender que a humanidade precisa fazer as pazes com o meio ambiente se quiser sobreviver.

Capitalism and Environmental Collapse Luiz Margues, 2020-08-17 This book intends to be an alert to the fact that the curve measuring environmental costs against the economic benefits of capitalism has irreversibly entered into a negative phase. The prospect of an environmental collapse has been evidenced by the sciences and the humanities since the 1960s. Today, it imposes its urgency. Finally, Margues argues that fitting back into the biosphere will only be possible if we dismantle the expansive socioeconomic gear that has shaped our societies since the 16th century by moving from a Social Contract to a Natural Contract, which takes into account the whole biosphere. According to him, the future society will be post-capitalist or it will not be a complex society, and even perhaps, we must fear, no society at all. Estudo das emissões e cenários de mitigação de gases de efeito estufa no setor de resíduos sólidos na Região Metropolitana do Recife/Pernambuco/Brasil Ana Maria Cardoso de Freitas Gama,2022-12-08 As mudanças climáticas, suas causas e consequências são reconhecidas pela comunidade científica, governos, setor privado e a população em geral, que admitem a necessidade de reduzir as emissões, devido ao aquecimento global. A gestão de resíduos sólidos urbanos (RSU) gera gases de efeito estufa (GEE). O Painel Intergovernamental sobre Mudanças Climática (IPCC) aponta o setor de resíduos como potencial emissor pela geração do gás metano (CH4), que é até 28 vezes maior do que o dióxido de carbono (CO2). Esta pesquisa objetivou avaliar a contribuição do setor de resíduos na Região Metropolitana do Recife (RMR) às emissões de GEE e definir cenários de mitigação para cumprimento da Contribuição Nacional Determinada (NDC) brasileira, fruto do Acordo de Paris. Realizou-se uma pesquisa exploratória, com revisão literária, seguida de uma análise documental de acordo com os requisitos do modelo do IPCC (2006). Foram realizadas visitas técnicas e entrevistas com gestores municipais. A RMR tem uma área de 3.216.262 km2, com uma população 4.054.866 habitantes, geração de 3.657.650,36 kg/dia de resíduos. Estimou-se que foram emitidas 25,4 milhões de tCO2e. Em uma análise comparativa entre os valores da NDC brasileira e aqueles encontrados nos cenários de mitigação, observou-se que seriam evitadas aproximadamente 36 milhões de tCO2e, pela disposição de RSU na RMR, equivalente a 52% de redução nas emissões em 2030, superior aos 47% assumidos pelo país no Acordo de Paris em 2015.

<u>A História da Política Nacional de Resíduos Sólidos</u> Lorena Saboya Vieira Soares,2022-05-02 Esta obra objetivou realizar uma avaliação política da Política Nacional de Resíduos Sólidos - PNRS, em sua concepção e desenho, com o escopo de desvelar determinantes sócio-históricas, sujeitos, interesses e racionalidades presentes no processo de formulação da política, bem como sua consistência e adequação ao tratamento satisfatório dos resíduos sólidos. Aprofundou-se o surgimento dos resíduos sólidos, suas causas e consequências, bem como a relação entre o homem e os resíduos sólidos, acompanhada de suas formas de tratamento e destinação final, além de reflexões acerca da formação da sociedade de consumo. Avaliou-se o contexto político e a influência dos sujeitos, o papel dos recursos, a conjuntura econômica do momento e a participação social no processo de formulação da PNRS. Compreendeu-se o desenho da PNRS, assim como a própria natureza da norma que a compôs e os princípios expressos que deram a sua forma. Demonstrou-se, a partir da análise de dados emitidos por estudos de instituições brasileiras, a realidade atual dos resíduos sólidos no Brasil e se refletiu acerca das peculiaridades locais e regionais não levadas em consideração no processo de formulação da PNRS e do relevante papel dos municípios, assim como críticas a respeito da participação popular no processo de formulação da PNRS. Conclui-se, assim, pela proposição da reformulação da política com a inclusão dos aspectos não incorporados na formulação anterior.

Site Investigation using Resistivity Imaging Sahadat Hossain,Golam Kibria,Sadik Khan,2018-08-06 Subsurface investigation is the most important phase of any civil engineering construction or development activities. The geologic conditions can be extremely complex, variable, and subject to change with time; soil test borings and in-situ tests are employed to obtain subsoil information. Resistivity Imaging (RI) is a non-destructive, fast and cost-effective method of site investigation and soil characterization. Site Investigation using Resistivity Imaging aims to summarize pertinent details of RI in site investigation for geotechnical and geo-

environmental applications. It aims to bridge the gap that currently exists between the geotechnical/geo-environmental and geophysical engineering community.
