Going to Hell to Get the Devil J. Christopher Schutz, 2024-03-20 The 1968 burning of the Lazy B Stables in Charlotte, North Carolina, attracted little notice beyond coverage in local media. By the mid-1970s, however, the fire had become the center of a contentious and dubious arson case against
