The dramatic flood of 1966 would be a seminal moment to give the right momentum to the project of Museo Internazionale di Arte Contemporanea, an institution being different from and complementary to Galleria d?Arte Moderna. In February 1967, the Artisti per Firenze exhibition, curated by Ragghianti in Palazzo Vecchio, testified to the artists? generous response to the appeal for the creation of MIAC, till the opening of Alberto Della Ragione Collection to the public in 1970.
