At the same time, the child will be able to view these phonetics in colorful pictures and then write (cursive) the word or phrase. These materials are presented to the child progressively, such that the phonetics that were grasped in the previous level are re-utilized at the next level. Following workbook 2c, the child will proceed to the workbook 3 series, to learn grammar and verb conjugation. Together, the complete series (Workbooks 1, 2, 3) will allow the child of 6 years old and beyond to learn the basics of the French language the vocabulary of reading, writing, and spelling; and associated grammar and verb conjugation.
