To Whom it May Concern Louise Bourgeois, Gary Indiana, 2011 ToWhom It May Concern is one of the final projects Louise Bourgeois completed, and is an apt demonstration of the enduring power of her work. Rich pinks, purples, reds and blues describe bodies comprising swollen bellies, heavy breasts, engorged phalluses and stooped torsos are presented in a series of pairings on facing pages. Deceptively simple in design, the varying intensity and range of colour within each figure reveals a dynamism in each repeated coupling of these headless, limbless bodies: male and female at their essential, and the relationship between the two, changing but the same. Philosophy and Politics at the Precipice Gary M. Kelly,2017-09-01 Philosophy and Politics at the Precipice maintains that political philosopher Alexandre Kojève (1901-68) has been both famously misunderstood and famous for being misunderstood. He became famously misunderstood when interpreters, at the end of the twentieth century, placed such an end at the center of his thought. above all, his long, complex and creative relationship with Simone de Beauvoir.
