The Bronze Age Towers at Bat, Sultanate of Oman Christopher P. Thornton, 2016 In the third millennium B.C.E., the Oman Peninsula was the site of an important kingdom known in Akkadian texts as Magan, which traded extensively with the Indus Civilization, southern Iran, the Persian Gulf states, and southern Mesopotamia.
