Exponentiation Using Canonical Recoding Ömer Nuri Eğecioğlu,Çetin K. Koç,1993 Abstract: The canonical bit recoding technique can be used to reduce the average number of multiplications required to compute $X^{[E]}$ provided that X^{-1} is supplied along with X . We model the generation of the digits of the canonical recoding D of an n - bit long exponent E as a Markov chain, and show that binary, quaternary, and octal methods applied to D require $4/3n$, $4/3n$, and $23/18n$ multiplications, compared to $3/2n$, $11/8n$, and $31/24n$ required by these methods applied to E . We show that in general the canonically recoded m - ary method for constant m requires fewer multiplications than the standard m -ary method. However, when m is picked optimally for each method for a given n , then the average number of multiplications required by the standard method is fewer than those required by the recoded version.
