The boundaries of the source zones are inexact, so that special study will be required for establishing credible ground-motion values for sites near the boundaries. Using the Murphy-O'Brien formulation, as well as theoretical results of Herrmann and a limited amount of strong-motion data for the central United States, equations are derived for that region which relate maximum horizontal acceleration and velocity to body-wave magnitude and epicentral distance.
