These immigrants took great pride in their homes and community and knew everyone on the block and provided an informal but effective neighborhood watch. When they were not sitting on the stoop they could be seen sweeping the sidewalks. One ritual that has faded from the experience of Italian Americans is Sunday Dinner with Sunday Gravy. It was a time when families sat and ate at a leisurely pace with grandparents, aunts, uncles, and cousins gathered in one home.
