The visual emphasis of all three contributions is supplemented by over one hundred illustrations, and because much of this material—on the more spectacular visual aspects of Italian opera—has never before appeared in English, Opera on Stage will be welcomed by scholars and opera enthusiasts alike.

Finally, Bokina offers a reappraisal of Henze's The Bassarids as a political opera that confronts the promise and limits of the sensual-sexual revolt of the twentieth-century.
