In 1946he became a member of the editorial board of the journal Annales, founded by Marc Bloch and Lucien Febvre. In 1949 he succeeded Febvre at the College de France. From 1962 to his death in 1985 Braudel was chief administrator of the Maison des Sciences de l'Homme. Fernand Braudel achieved a worldwide reputation for his line of approach that united history and other social studies. His Civilization and Capitalism and The Mediterranean were widely acclaimed. The second volume of Fernand Braudel's monumental The Identity of France was published in 1990.
