At least, if water reduces to H₂O, then H₂O does not reduce to water. But how can this be, if water is identical to H₂O? The book shows that the application of current models of reduction does not solve this puzzle, and proposes a new coherent definition, according to which unity is tied to identity, diversity is descriptive in nature, and directionality is the directionality of explanation.
