Terminología El ícono oriental es una Imagen-Palabra. Su trayectoria histórica y teológica converge en la unidad de la Palabra-Imagen, porque capta la Palabra de Dios como Imagen. Por eso es sobretodo un arte litúrgico, que comunica de alguna forma el misterio que lo representa. Los griegos tenían dos términos para describir las imágenes de los dioses: agalmata que era la tendencia de dar a los dioses un cuerpo bello, vivo, real y eidolon que era una imagen sin profundidad, una sombra o fantasma. Las imágenes que expresaban una realidad histórica eran llamadas eikones, y los cristianos adoptaron este término para su arte. Esto indica que para ellos el ícono es una realidad histórica opuesta a la imagen mítica de los dioses. Mejor dicho, es una imagen histórica, la representación es posible sólo a partir de un hecho histórico la entrada de Dios en nuestro mundo con la Encarnación, simbólica, es un puente entre dos realidades humana-divina y teológica, ya que tiene un contenido conceptual, pero expresado no por la escritura sino a través de la imagen. En los iconos que vamos a analizar explicaremos sobre todo la parte teológica y simbólica, intentando aclarar el sentido menos conocido de la estructura o del color o la técnica que los pintores orientales usaban para representar esta mezcla única de divino y humano, que predomina toda la cultura cristiana.

The Illuminating Icon Anthony Ugolnik, 1989 This is a print on demand book and is therefore non-returnable. In Christ there is no East or West, claims a familiar hymn. But the truth is that American Christians know little about Russian Orthodox Christians and harbor many misconceptions about them. In this revealing book Anthony Ugolnik shows how the thousand-year-old Russian Orthodox tradition actively shapes the life of contemporary Russian Christians, and he points out how Russian Orthodoxy can inform and enrich American Christianity. Ugolnik speaks from a unique perspective: of Russian descent, he is an American Christian who has a strong and genuine personal bond with Russian Christians. Ugolnik begins his discussion by exploring the alienation between Russians and Americans - a cultural and religious alienation that is still very strong today, despite changing rhetoric and glasnost. Americans tend to picture Russian Christians as cowed and ragged masses; on the contrary, says Ugolnik, they are a stalwart, strong community. American Christians also tend to be suspicious about the role of icons in Russian Orthodox worship. But Ugolnik points out that icons are not idols; rather, they are religious objects that image forth the majesty of God. This powerful sense of the holy that pervades Russian Orthodoxy could reinvigorate American Christianity. Indeed, the Russian Orthodox have much to offer American Christians, according to Ugolnik. They place a much greater emphasis on community in their life and worship -- an emphasis that could help transform the individualistic faith of many American Christians. Similarly, the Orthodox emphasis on historical and spiritual continuity -- in contrast to the imagery of restoration and revival in Reformation Christianity -- could strengthen the worship and witness of American Christians. And the Orthodox sense of the beautiful -- born of a complex aesthetics that undergirds Russian faith and culture -- could enrich the foundation as well as the expression of American Christianity. In the end, American and Russian Christians share the common dilemma of how to relate to the secular world around them, and the Russian Orthodox emphasis on dialogue and engagement could vitalize the way American Christians live out their faith. In this multifaceted book Ugolnik weaves personal experiences with richly developed explorations of Russian and American belief and incisive observations that draw on the literature, philosophy, theology, and history of both cultures. With both passion and compassion Ugolnik urges Russian and American Christians to look to the illuminating icon of our incarnate God for guidance: Let that icon draw us deep into the mystery of a shared life in the Spirit.

El ícono y el hacha James H. Billington, 2015-01-12 Esta es una historia interpretativa de la cultura y el pensamiento ruso modernos. No tiene la ilusión -ni la pretensión- de ofrecer un inventario enciclopédico del patrimonio ruso o una clave sencilla para comprenderla. Es, ante todo, un relato selectivo que busca abrir más que cubrir este amplísimo tema y no simplemente codificar un consenso ya establecido.
