Victorians in the Mountains Professor Ann C Colley,2013-04-28 In her compelling book, Ann C. Colley concludes by offering insights into the ways in which expeditions to the Himalayas affected people's sense of the sublime, arguing that these individuals were motivated as much by the glory of Empire as by aesthetic sensibility.
