Were journalists to employ different methods of news gathering, Fishman concludes, a different reality would emerge in the news-one that

might challenge the legitimacy of prevailing political structures. But, under the traditional system, news reports will continue to support the interests of the status quo independently of the attitudes and intentions of reporters, editors, and news sources.
