Thierer is a Senior Fellow at PFF and Director of PFF's Center for Digital Media Freedom, and is also a member of the Internet Safety Technical Task Force, chaired by the Berkman Center for Internet & Society at Harvard Law School. online child safety or propose to regulate content on the Internet.
