Asphalt Rubber Glenn A. Fager, 2001 From 1990 to 1995 a total of 13 projects were constructed using crumb tire rubber in the state of Kansas. These projects were built in response to a state legislature request to evaluate the feasibility of the use of crumb tire rubber in highway construction. Six projects were constructed through change orders and seven were administrated through normal bid procedures. High-density mixes, recycle mixes, and open graded mixes were employed in the experiment. Five projects were by the modified dry process and eight were by the wet process. Approximately 2,637 tons of crumb tire rubber were used in all of the 13 projects. A rating system was established to evaluate the effectiveness of each project. Almost all of the crumb tire rubber came from outside of the state; very little was used from Kansas generated sources.
