The Chironomidae P.D. Armitage, L.C. Pinder, P.S. Cranston, 2012-12-06 The dipteran family Chironomidae is the most widely distributed and frequently the most abundant group of insects in freshwater, with rep resentatives in both terrestrial and marine environments. A very wide range of gradients of temperature, pH, oxygen concentration, salinity, current velocity, depth, productivity, altitude and latitude have been exploited, by at least some chironomid species, and in grossly polluted environments chironomids may be the only insects present. Recent works, including genetic studies, have meant that the family is receiving much more attention globally.
