In living systems, transmission within the neural network involves coded nerve impulses and other physical chemical processes that form reflections of sensory stimuli and incipient motor behavior. Spatial Memory Jacob B. Thomas, 2010 A fundamental requirement of everyday life is that of encoding and remembering successfully the locations of objects, landmarks or buildings in space. This function is achieved by structuring spatial information in systems of coordinates. It is often argued that a person's, or an animal's, spatial memories are summarized in a cognitive map. There are two main categories for classifying spatial reference systems. One is the egocentric frame of reference which specifies location and orientation with respect to the organism and include eye, head and body coordinates. Allocentric frames of reference specify location and orientation with respect to elements and features of the environment independently of the viewer's position.
