A dog food grading system is good and useful to weed-out the poor quality foods so that you have an easier time choosing between the higher-quality foods. The highest scoring dog food may not be the best-suited one for your dog. Each dog has basic needs, but some may require specific formulations for optimal health. All of this can be very confusing for dog owners. If a dog does well on a dog food with no secondary health problems, then the food might be adequate for the dogs well-being and for the dog's current life-stage. Remember: a dog's different life-stages require different nutritional formulations and a switch in foods may be necessary a few times during your dog's lifespan. Switching diets can be hard on some dogs and can cause digestive problems and diarrhea. Some owners automatically attribute these problems to the new food, which may not be the case. To help reduce this problem, a mixture of the two foods can be fed before completely switching. The health benefits from a new food may not be noticeable for 3-8 weeks.
