This is how most hands end in Texas Hold'em and that's the magic of the game - you don't always need the best hand to win. Now let's recap... Okay, let's go over how a Texas Holdem poker hand works using only poker slang and see if you can keep up. Firstly, you are dealt your hole cards. Then there is a round of betting. Then the players remaining see a flop. Then there is another round of betting. Then you see a turn card. Then another round of betting. Then a final river card. Then one more round of betting.
