Together with three invited talks (by Emile Aarts, Philips Research, Candy Sidner, Mitsubishi Research, and Eric Horvitz, Microsoft Research), the AH 2004 papers provide an excellent view on the successful approaches for innovative personalization and adaptation functionalities in a variety of areas, including eLearning, eCommerce, mobile tourist guides and many more. They also show the integration of personalization functionalities being employed in Web environments, in ambient intelligence and intelligent agent contexts, and building upon adaptive hypermedia and Semantic Web technologies, Web search, Web services, social and peer-to-peer networks, and recommender systems, among others.
