A more complete description was given by pathologist Rudolf Virchow in 1845. Approximately ten years after Virchow's findings, pathologist Franz Ernst Christian Neumann found that the bone marrow of a deceased person with leukaemia was coloured filthy green-yellow as opposed to the normal red. This finding allowed Neumann to conclude that a bone marrow problem was responsible for the strange blood of people with leukaemia. Observing an abnormally large number of white blood cells in a blood sample from a person, Virchow called the condition Leukämie in German, which he formed by the two Greek words leukos (λευκός), meaning white, and haima (αἷμα), meaning blood. Leukaemia is a cancerous disorder of white blood cells, which are responsible for fighting infection. Similar to the other sorts of blood cell in the body (red blood cells, which carry oxygen; and platelets, which help control bleeding), white blood cells form in the bone marrow, a spongy material that fills the bones. In the bone marrow, immature cells multiply and mature into Red cells, white cells and platelets. As they mature, they're released into the bloodstream. In leukaemia, the white blood cells instead of growing and developing normally grow out of control and do not mature. This uncontrolled growth of immature white blood cells can crowd the bone marrow preventing it from producing healthy white blood cells, red blood cells and platelets. Leukaemia is a blood cancer caused by a rise in the number of white blood cells in the body. Those white blood cells crowd out the red blood cells and Platelets that your body needs to be healthy.
